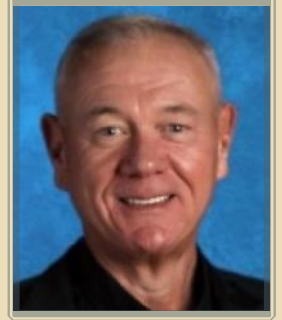
Our Challenge

Dear friends,

The prophet Malachi saw the coming of the Lord as a painful encounter. The day of his coming will be like the refiner's fire and the fuller's lye. When the Lord comes to the temple, he will refine and purify his people. But he does this only because we are so valuable to him. We are God's silver and gold collection that needs to be polished. Suffering as a test runs throughout the scriptures. The author of the book of Hebrews portrays the death of Christ as the test of his obedience to the divine purpose for his life. He came to this earth as a real human being to undergo and overcome the travails and temptations of human life so that we might be freed from the powers of death. When Joseph and Mary presented the baby Jesus for the ritual of purification in the temple they were met by an aged saint who recognized the child as the Messiah. Simeon took the child in his arms and blessed God that he had lived long enough to witness God's saving deed for all peoples, both Jew and Gentile. There is a well-known saying among athletes in training and patients in rehabilitation: "No pain, no gain." We have to push ourselves outside the comfort zone to build physical strength and muscle. The same is true in the spiritual order of things. God scours our lives with a refiner's fire to burn away our self-centered and self-serving attitudes and actions. We know that our lives need scouring and polishing. We do not shine as brightly as we should with the beauty and brightness of our faith. *Prosperity* is a great teacher but *adversity* is a greater teacher. The greatest depths of wisdom have been forged in the heat of adversity. The abrasive dust of adversity has polished the finest gems of creativity. Though losses and crosses are severe burdens, there is strength in shouldering those burdens that we will find nowhere else.
