

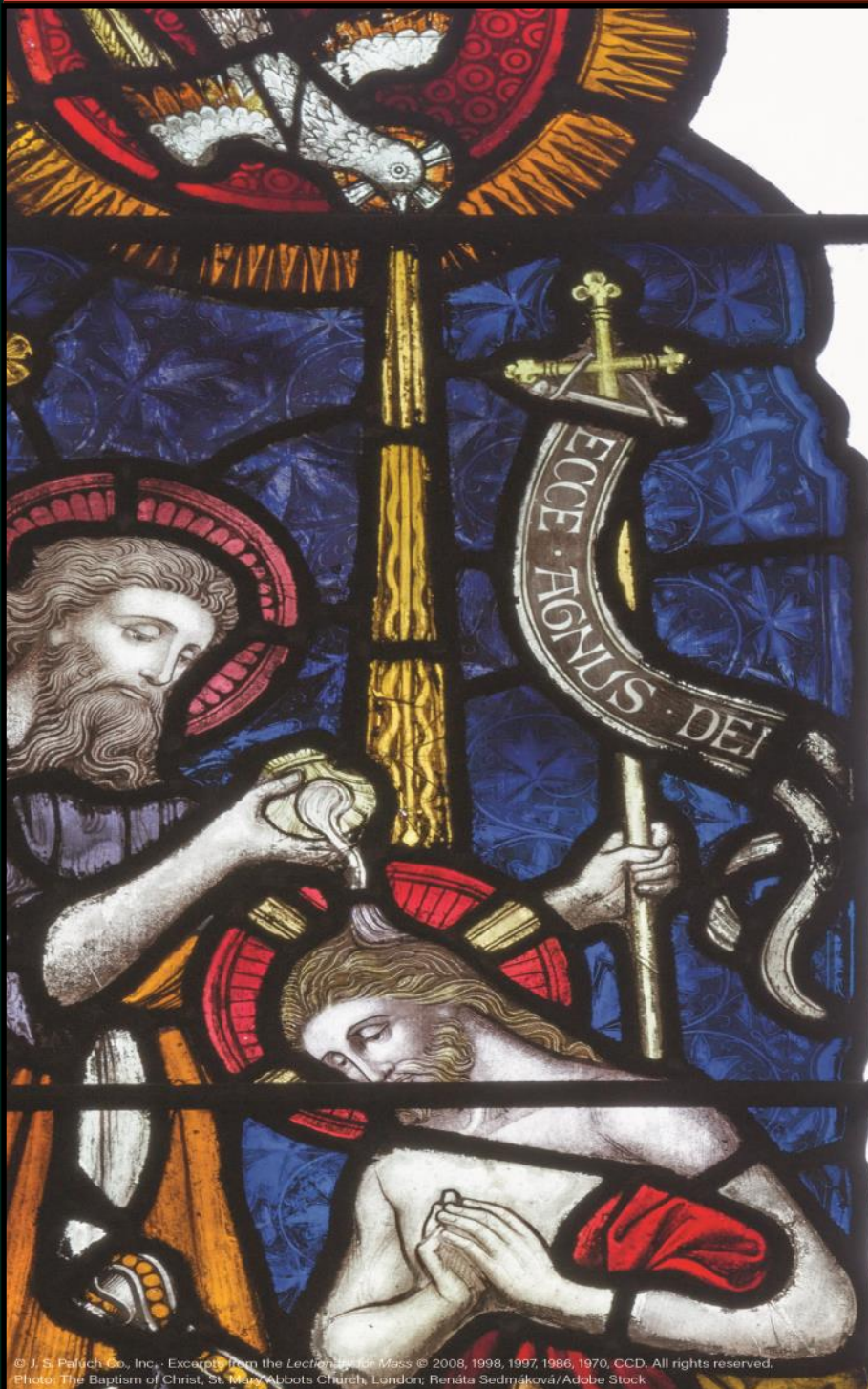

Baptism & Confirmation sponsors must be Confirmed, practicing Catholics and will need to provide a letter of good standing from the parish in which they are registered.

Our Challenge

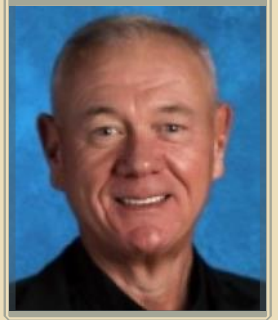
Dear friends,

To accomplish redemptive purposes in human history God works through human beings. Some individuals are chosen for special work of reconciliation. But redemptive results never come easily. The price of reconciliation is vicarious suffering. Paul was called to be an apostle of Christ Jesus. This high office cost him dearly, however. He became an outcast among his own people. He was beaten, shipwrecked, imprisoned, and stoned. He bore all this undeserved suffering for the sake of Jesus' mission to the Gentile world. A great mystery of our faith is that the world's sin is overcome by innocent suffering. Police power and corporal punishment may *contain* sin, but they can never *conquer* sin. Suffering for the sake of others, guilty and innocent alike, is the only way that evil hearts are softened and lives changed. We do not live in a perfect universe. Sinners are not always punished, and saints are not always rewarded. The earthly consequences of sin sometimes fall on the innocent rather than the guilty. Such undeserved suffering strains our sense of the justice of the universe. But, strange as it seems, these inequities do not destroy the moral order of things. It is hard enough dealing with sufferings of our own making. It is infinitely more difficult to suffer the consequences of the sins of others. Yet, Jesus taught us to bear one another's burdens, whether or not we deserve such suffering. Gandhi and Martin Luther King, Jr. proved the power of non-violent love. Gandhi brought the British Empire to its knees through passive resistance to age-old prejudices. King stirred our nation's conscience through passive resistance to unjust laws. But both men paid with their lives for their campaigns on behalf of the downtrodden.

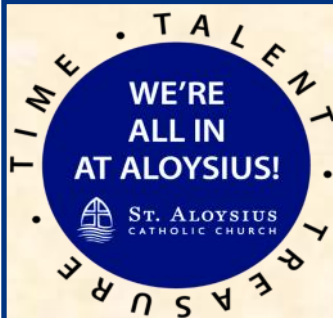

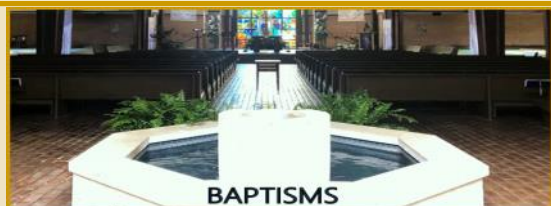

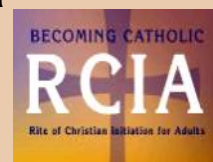
