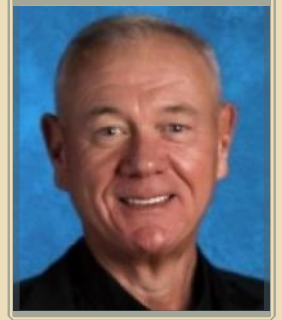
Our Challenge

Dear friends,

One of the ironies of our worldly loyalties is that they ultimately take a terrible toll. The prophet Isaiah describes this price in vivid images. Such loyalties are like a yoke that burdens us and a taskmaster that continually drives us with a rod. The apostle Paul was terribly upset to learn of the factions that divided the church at Corinth. In his view, ultimate loyalty belonged only to Christ. Putting the messengers of Christ on the same level with Christ was a recipe for disaster. A great thing about Jesus is that he demands the best from his followers. Those who followed him as his first disciples were adventurers who were eager to test themselves in a cause greater than themselves. They readily abandoned their mundane work to take part in a heavenly conquest. We only find ourselves by giving ourselves to someone else or something bigger than ourselves. We are inescapably a part of the things we cherish, the groups to which we belong, and the causes we defend. The only questions are: which things, which groups, and which causes? When we make these choices we are shaping our destinies. The Christian faith is a challenge of the highest order. Christ is the Great Light that draws us out of the darkness of our narrow loyalties without sacrificing our individual differences. Consider a trite but true saying: *"The world's smallest package is the person who is all wrapped up in herself or himself."* The wider the range of our relationships, the richer our joys. The deeper our values and commitments, the stronger our characters and our lives. When we give ourselves to strength, we receive strength in return.

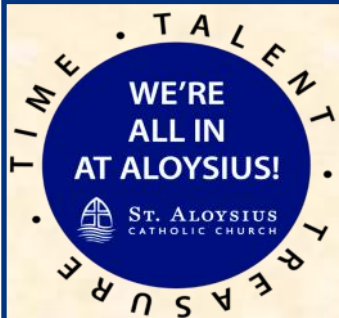

STEWARDSHIP OF OFFERING

"Others have made offerings from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has offered her whole livelihood." (Luke 21:4)

The poor widow in Luke's gospel was in stark contrast to the rich Pharisees and hypocrites flaunting their wealth at the temple on that day. The rich people were trying to get noticed while she was trying to remain inconspicuous. Jesus however was watching and saw what she had done. Hers was a lesson on true piety demonstrated in giving and trust.

Piety is the quality of being devoutly religious, being reverent toward God and devoted to worshiping him. The religious leaders of that time portrayed themselves as pious but were not reverent toward God and their worship of him was false. The poor widow demonstrated true devotion, reverence toward God and true worship of him.

Piety in giving is about worship. It is about trusting God to supply your needs as you worship and obey him. People tend to judge piety in charity by the amount given. However, piety in giving is not about large sums, but rather in sacrificial giving. Giving is simply a reflection of the heart. What is your love for God? What is your love for the things of this world? Are you seeking after the kingdom of God or your own kingdom? Are you learning to trust God for your future, or are you still relying on your own resources and abilities?

We continue to ask you to prayerfully reflect upon your Stewardship of Offering for the upcoming year. Please consider how your financial commitments can best reflect the generous people we are called to be. 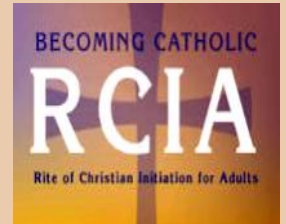
